

Supplier Quality Requirements

In Tolerance, Inc.

Purpose: This document defines the requirements of In Tolerance, Inc. for supplying of raw material, hardware, and vended services.

1. Orders shall meet all specifications per In Tolerance requirements stated on the purchase order and related documents.
2. Material suppliers shall comply with DFARS 252.225-7014, preference for domestic specialty metals alternate 1.
3. The supplier shall flow down all requirements of In Tolerance to their sub-tier suppliers, including key characteristics where required.
4. The supplier shall notify In Tolerance of changes in product and/or process definition and, where required, obtain approval from In Tolerance.
5. The supplier shall immediately notify In Tolerance of any suspected nonconforming product already shipped.
6. All suppliers shall retain inspection and test records for three years.
7. The supplier shall afford In Tolerance, its customer and any applicable regulatory agencies, the right of access to all facilities and quality records involved in the fulfillment of the applicable purchase order.
8. The supplier shall comply with all applicable U.S. export control laws and regulations including the requirements of the International Traffic in Arms Regulation (ITAR), 22 C.F.R. 120 - 130. Supplier will not transfer any export controlled item, data, or services, to include transfer to foreign persons employed by or associated with, or under contract to Supplier or Supplier's Subcontractors, without the authority of an export license, agreement, or applicable exemption or exception.
